RESOLUTION: "To adopt Bill No. 4 of 2021, Ordinance No. 1556, **An Ordinance Adopting the Quality of Life and Violations Ticket Process in the City of Connellsville** with the purpose of enforcing lack of maintenance of properties, littering, improper storage of trash and rubbish, storage of inoperable/non-registered vehicles, vendor operations without permits and accumulation of snow and ice are costly problems that contribute to the deterioration of property values and general disorder in a community. These problems degrade the physical appearance of the city, which reduces business and tax revenue inhibiting economic development.
